



Kidney Health Evaluation for Patients with Diabetes (KED)

HEDIS® Measurement Year 2024

Measure Description: The percentage of members 18-85 years of age with diabetes (type 1 and type 2) who received a kidney health evaluation, defined by an estimated glomerular filtration rate (eGFR) and a urine albumin-creatinine ratio (uACR), during the measurement year.

- At least one eGFR is required during the measurement year period.
- At least one uACR is required during the measurement year period.
 - The uACR is identified by the member having **both** a quantitative urine albumin test **and** a urine creatinine test **with** services dates four or less days apart.

Eligible Population

Members 18-85 years of age with type 1 or type 2 diabetes. The following age stratifications are reported:

- 18-64 years
- 65-75 years
- 76-85 years
- Total

Product Lines

Commercial, Medicaid, Medicare

Data Collection Method

Administrative (claims), Supplemental data

Exclusions

Members are excluded from the measure if they meet the following criteria:

- Members who are in hospice.
- Members who are in palliative care.
- Members 66 years of age and older as of December 31 with a frailty and advanced illness diagnosis during the measurement year.
- Members with evidence of end stage renal disease (ESRD) or dialysis any time during the members history through December 31 of the measurement year.

Measure Compliance (numerator)

Both an eGFR and a uACR during the measurement year on the same or different dates of service:

- At least one eGFR
- At least one uACR identified by either of the following:
 - Both a quantitative urine albumin test and a urine creatinine test with service dates four days or less apart.
 - A uACR
