



Osteoporosis Management in Women Who Had a Fracture (OMW)

HEDIS® Measurement Year 2024

Measure Description: Assesses the percentage of women 67-85 years of age who suffered a fracture between July 1 of the year prior to the measurement year, through June 30 of the measurement year, and who had either a bone mineral density test (BMD) or a prescription for a drug to treat osteoporosis in the six months (180 days) after the fracture.

Eligible Population

Women 67-85 years of age who suffered a fracture.

Data Collection Method

Administrative (claims), Supplemental data

Exclusions

Members are excluded from the measure if they meet the following criteria:

- Members who are in hospice or receiving palliative care.
- Bone mineral density test within 24 months prior to the episode date*.
- Osteoporosis therapy or dispensed prescription medication within 12 months prior to the episode date*.
- Fractures of the finger, toe, face and skull.
- Members 66 years of age and older with a diagnosis of frailty and advanced illness during the measurement year.

**Episode date: the earliest date of service with a fracture diagnosis within the time frame specified above (July- June).*

Measure Compliance (numerator)

Appropriate testing or treatment for osteoporosis after the fracture defined by any of the following criteria:

- A bone mineral density test on the episode date or in the 180-day period after the fracture.
- Osteoporosis therapy on the episode date or in the 180-day period after the fracture.
- A dispensed prescription to treat osteoporosis on the episode date or in the 180-day period after the fracture.
