Measure Description: Assesses the percentage of males 21-75 years of age and females 40-75 years of age during the measurement year, who were identified as having clinical atherosclerotic cardiovascular disease (ASCVD) and met the following criteria. The following rates are reported:

- Received Statin Therapy: Members who were dispensed at least one high-intensity or moderate-intensity statin medication during the measurement year.
- Statin Adherence 80%: Members who remained on a high-intensity or moderate-intensity statin medication for at least 80% of the treatment period.

## Eligible Population

Males 21-75 years of age and females 40-75 years of age who were identified as having clinical atherosclerotic cardiovascular disease (ASCVD).

#### Exclusions

Members are excluded from the measure if they meet the following criteria:

- Members who are in hospice or receiving palliative care.
- Members 66 years of age and older as of December 31 of the measurement year with a frailty and advanced illness diagnosis during the measurement year.
- Members diagnosed with myalgia, myositis, myopathy, or rhabdomyolysis.
- Members diagnosed with cirrhosis, dialysis, ESRD, or pregnancy.

# Measure Compliance (numerator)

Adherence is determined by the member being prescribed and remaining on their high or moderate-intensity statin medications for 80% of their treatment period. This is determined by pharmacy claims data. Two rates are reported:

Numerator 1 – Received Statin Therapy

The number of members who had at least one dispensing event for a high-intensity or moderate-intensity statin medication.

Numerator 2 – Statin Adherence 80%

The number of members who had at least one dispensing event for a high-intensity or moderate-intensity statin medication and remained on the medication for at least 80% of their treatment period.
