Measure Description: The percentage of women 16-24 years of age who were identified as sexually active and who had at least one test for chlamydia during the measurement year.

Claim/encounter data and pharmacy data is used to identify sexually active women by a diagnosis for pregnancy or sexual activity, or pregnancy test, or by dispensed prescription contraceptives.

Women ages 16-24 years old as of December 31 of the measurement year.
