



Eye Exam for Patients with Diabetes (EED)

HEDIS® Measurement Year 2024

Measure Description: The percentage of members 18-75 years of age with a diagnosis of diabetes (Type 1 and Type 2) who had a retinal eye exam.

Eligible Population

Members 18-75 years of age with a diagnosis of diabetes.

Product Lines

Commercial, Medicaid, Medicare

Data Collection Method

Administrative (claims), Supplemental data, Hybrid (medical record)

Note: The EED measure is hybrid. Any care not received via claims during the measurement year will result in medical record requests during the HEDIS medical record review project.

Exclusions

Members are excluded from the measure if they meet the following criteria:

- Members who are in hospice or palliative care.
- Members 66 years of age and older as of December 31 of the measurement year who have both a frailty and an advanced illness diagnosis.

Measure Compliance (numerator)

Screening or monitoring for diabetic retinal disease as identified by one of the following exams performed in the measurement year or the year prior to the measurement year.

- Retinal or dilated eye exam must be performed by an eye care professional (optometrist or ophthalmologist) in the measurement year.
- A **negative** retinal or dilated eye exam (negative for retinopathy) by an eye care professional in the year prior to the measurement year.
- Bilateral eye enucleation any time during the member's history through December 31 of the measurement year.
