



Cervical Cancer Screening (CCS)

HEDIS® Measurement Year 2024

Measure Description: The percentage of women 21-64 years of age who were screened for cervical cancer using one of the following criteria:

- Women 21-64 years of age who had a cervical cytology performed within the last 3 years.
- Women 30-64 years of age who had cervical high-risk human papillomavirus (hrHPV) testing performed within the last 5 years.
- Women 30-64 years of age who had a cervical cytology/high-risk human papillomavirus HPV (hrHPV) co-testing performed every 5 years.

Eligible Population

Members 21-64 years of age as of December 31 of the measurement year.

Product Lines

Commercial, Medicaid

Data Collection Method

Administrative (claims), Supplemental data, Hybrid (medical record)

The CCS measure is hybrid. Any care not received via claims during the measurement year will result in medical record requests during the HEDIS medical record review project.

Exclusions

Members are excluded from the measure if they meet the following criteria:

- Members who are in hospice or palliative care.
- Hysterectomy with no residual cervix, cervical agenesis or acquired absence of cervix at any time during the member's history through December 31 of the measurement year.

Measure Compliance (numerator)

The number of members recommended for routine cervical cancer screening who were screened for cervical cancer. Refer to the table below to determine test and date of service based on age.

Measure	Age Range	Valid DOS
Cervical Cancer Screening	21-64	Measurement year and two years prior
Cervical Cancer Screening w/hrHPV co-testing	30-64	Measurement year and four years prior
Cervical high-risk human papillomavirus (hrHPV) testing	30-64	Measurement year and four years prior
