



Lead Screening in Children (LSC)

HEDIS® Measurement Year 2024

Measure Description: The percentage of children 2 years of age who had one or more capillary or venous lead blood test for lead poisoning by their second birthday.

*Members must have at least one lead capillary or venous blood test on or before the child's second birthday.

Eligible Population

Children who turn 2 years of age during the measurement year.

Data Collection Method

Administrative (claims), Supplemental data

Exclusions

Members are excluded from the measure if they meet the following criteria:

- Members who are in hospice.

Measure Compliance (numerator)

A lead capillary or venous blood test on or before the child's second birthday.
