



Glycemic Status Assessment for Patients with Diabetes (GSD)

HEDIS® Measurement Year 2024

Measure Description: The percentage of members 18-75 years of age with diabetes whose most recent glycemic status (hemoglobin A1c [HbA1c] or glucose management indicator [GMI]) was at the following levels during the measurement year:

- Glycemic Status <8.0%
- Glycemic Status >9.0%

A level less than 9.0% indicates better performance.

Eligible Population

Ages 18-75 years of age with a diagnosis for diabetes (Type 1 and Type 2).

Product Lines

Commercial, Medicaid, Medicare

Data Collection Method

Administrative (claims), Supplemental data, Hybrid (medical record)

Note: The GSD measure is hybrid. Any care not received via claims during the measurement year will result in medical record requests during the HEDIS medical record review project.

Exclusions

Members are excluded from the measure if they meet the following criteria:

- Members 66 years of age and older as of Dec. 31 of the measurement year who have both a frailty and an advanced illness diagnosis.
- Members who are in hospice or palliative care.

Measure Compliance (numerator) – Glycemic Status and Results

Identify the most recent glycemic status assessment (HbA1c or GMI) and result during the measurement year. The member is numerator compliant if the result is <8.0%.

The member is not numerator compliant if the most recent result is ≥8.0%, the result is missing, or if the glycemic status assessment was not done during the measurement year.

At a minimum, documentation in the medical record must include a note indicating the date when the glycemic status assessment was performed and the result.

Ranges and thresholds do not meet criteria; a distinct numeric result is required for numerator compliance.

CPT-CAT-II	3044F	Most recent hemoglobin A1c (HbA1c) level less than 7.0%
CPT-CAT-II	3046F	Most recent hemoglobin A1c level greater than 9.0%
CPT-CAT-II	3051F	Most recent hemoglobin A1c (HbA1c) level greater than or equal to 7.0% and less than 8.0%
CPT-CAT-II	3052F	Most recent hemoglobin A1c (HbA1c) level greater than or equal to 8.0% and less than or equal to 9.0%
